

## **BPI Distributor Rules & Regulations**

1. Applicant must be 18 years of the age and above.
2. Upon BPI accepting the applicant to be BPI's distributor, the applicant will automatically be recognized as a distributor of BPI and the distributorship will remain valid as long as distributor abide by and conform to the BPI Distributor Rules & Regulations as stated in BPI Distributor's Manual.
3. Distributor has studied the BPI Distributor's Manual as well as the Direct Selling Act and distributor agrees to abide by all the operational procedures, rules & regulations therein stated. Distributor acknowledges that any violation of the Terms of Agreement, the BPI Distributor's Code and Ethics, Rules and Regulations or any obligations distributor may have with BPI, may result in the termination of the distributorship or other disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the BPI Management.
4. Termination of a distributorship for whatsoever reason(s) in any country, whether in the First Country or any Host Countries, will automatically result in the termination of distributorship in all countries whereupon all benefits, privileges and recognition of the distributor shall cease immediately.
5. In the process of sponsoring new recruits and promoting BPI's products, distributor shall not violate the Direct Selling Act and induce customers by quoting exceptional example, misappropriate money of downline, distributor or customers, or accept any form of corrupt offers.
6. Without prior approval from BPI Management, distributor shall refrain from:
  - Promoting BPI's products and/or BPI activities through any form of the advertisement; or
  - Recruiting new distributor through media.
7. BPI reserves the right to accept or reject any application form for any reason at its discretion including applications that contain incomplete, inaccurate, false or misleading information. Any alteration or modifications will be subjected to verification.

8. Distributors are solely responsible for the compliance with applicable taxation requirements.
9. At any time, the distributor's action or conduct must not damage BPI's interest and reputations.
10. Distributor has to renew the annual subscription of BPI membership, where applicable, at the prevailing rate determined by the respective countries through direct payment at the respective Host Country offices.
11. Upon registration of a distributorship in a Host Country, the distributor will be accorded the same status as in the First Country. However, distributors have to fulfil local qualification criteria to enjoy the benefits, privileges and recognitions of Host Country.
12. The laws of Malaysia shall govern this Agreement.
13. Distributor agrees to keep abreast and be bound by all changes and updates.
14. BPI reserves the rights to amend the Terms of Agreement and BPI Distributor Manual without any prior notice or explanation
